**The Executive Elevator Pitch: How to Sell the Value of CCLR**

District leaders are often asked to explain the importance of college, career, and life readiness (CCLR) in just a few minutes. This session gives administrators a framework for building an “executive elevator pitch” that resonates with superintendents, boards, and senior leaders. Participants will practice translating the strategic value of CCLR into clear, compelling language that ties directly to student outcomes, accountability, and workforce priorities. Through role-play and peer coaching, attendees will leave with a polished pitch they can adapt for different audiences.


